

More Abundant Life: Salvation and Provision

We extend greetings to the church at SouthEastSide with the bishops and the power that sits in the pews. John chapter 10 details Jesus alluding to the Sheepfold, Door, Thieves, Robbers, Stealing and Killing. He articulates that He has come to provide life and life more abundantly.

¹ Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that enters not by the door into the sheepfold, but climbs up some other way, the same is a thief and a robber. ² But he that enters in by the door is the shepherd of the sheep. ³ To him the porter openeth; and the sheep hear his voice: and he calleth his own sheep by name, and leadeth them out. ⁴ And when he putteth forth his own sheep, he goes before them, and the sheep follow him: for they know his voice. ⁵ And a stranger will they not follow, but will flee from him: for they know not the voice of strangers. ⁶ This parable spake Jesus unto them: but they understood not what things they were which he spake unto them. ⁷ Then said Jesus unto them again, Verily, verily, I say unto you, I am the door of the sheep. ⁸ All that ever came before me are thieves and robbers: but the sheep did not hear them. ⁹ I am the door: by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture. ¹⁰ The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: **I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.** ¹¹ I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd gives his life for the sheep. ¹² But he that is an hireling, and not the shepherd, whose own the sheep are not, sees the wolf coming, and leaveth the sheep, and flees: and the wolf catches them, and scatters the sheep. ¹³ The hireling flees, because he is an hireling, and cares not for the sheep. ¹⁴ I am the good shepherd, and know my sheep, and am known of mine. ¹⁵ As the Father knoweth me, even so know I the Father: and I lay down my life for the sheep. [John 10:1-15] Jesus is the Door, the Entrance into the sheepfold and warns that all who try to enter therein some other way are thieves and robbers. Any person that enters through Him/ Jesus will 1) be saved/received salvation and 2) go in and out of the sheepfold to find pasture/nourishment. There is a huge difference the Good Shepherd and a Hireling. Jesus is the Good Shepherd who gives His life for His sheep. The Hireling 1) does not own the sheep 2) flees from and leaves the sheep when he sees the wolf coming and 3) does not care for the sheep because he is a Hireling and is not the Good Shepherd.

Now SouthEastSide we commend you to God and to the word of His grace, which is able to build us up in the most holy faith and to give us an inheritance among all those who are sanctified.
