- God's Plan To Save Mankind is an Eternal Plan that existed in His mind before the World of Humankind began.

Ephesians 1:4 ⁴ According as *He has chosen us in Him before the foundation of the world*, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love:

The context is Ephesians 1:1-11

- ¹ Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the *will of God, to the saints which are at Ephesus, and to the faithful in Christ Jesus:
 - Writer: The Apostle Paul
 - An Apostle of Jesus Christ "by the will of God"
 - Primary Recipients:
 - The saints/members of the church at Ephesus (Gentile Asia Minor)
 - o Paul's 1st visit to Ephesus:
 - 2nd Missionary Journey Acts 18:18-21
 - Departed from Corinth with Aquila & Priscilla
 - Entered Jewish synagogue and reasoned with the Jews
 - Denied their request that he stay longer

- Departed to make a feast at Jerusalem
- Promised to return to Ephesus
- o Acts 18:24-26 Apollos came to Ephesus
 - Mighty and eloquent in the scriptures
 - Taught in the Jewish synagogues; <u>instructed in the way of the</u> Lord
 - Knowing and teaching only the "Baptism of John"
 - *Limited knowledge [1st century vs. 21st century]
 - Aquila and Priscilla expounded unto him *the way of God more perfectly
- o Paul's 2nd visit to Ephesus
 - 3rd Missionary Journey 54 A.D. Acts 19 [19:1-41]; Departed for Macedonia Acts 20:1
 - 19:1-8
 - While Apollos was at Corinth; Paul encountered disciples who knew only the "Baptism of John"
 - Taught them, baptized them, they were added to the church
 - * Went into the Jewish synagogue 3 months
 - Disputing and Persuading things Concerning the Kingdom of God 1:11
 - 19:9-10
 - Departed the synagogue; separated the disciples/church/members of the Kingdom
 - *Preached from the school of Tyrannus 2 years
 - *All who dwelt in Asia Minor heard the word of the Lord Jesus
 - *Both Jews and Greeks/non-Jews/Gentiles

The saints at Ephesus

- 1:1 Ephesus & and *all in Asia Minor [*faithful in Christ Jesus 19:9-10]
- 1:4 whom God chose before the foundation of the world
- Were Jews and Gentiles [Acts 19:9-10]
- 1:5 *Predestinated to the Adoption of Children

- ¹ Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, to the saints which are at Ephesus, and to the faithful in Christ Jesus:
- ² Grace be to you, and peace, from God our Father, and from the Lord Jesus Christ.
- ³ Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ:
- ⁴According as *he has chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love:
- 5* Having predestinated us unto the adoption of children * by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will,
- ⁶To the praise of the glory of his grace, wherein he hath made us accepted in the beloved.
- ⁷ In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace;
- ⁸ Wherein he hath abounded toward us in all wisdom and prudence; ⁹ <u>Having</u> made known unto us the *mystery of his will, according to his good pleasure which he hath purposed in himself:
- ¹⁰ That in the dispensation of the fulness of times he might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven, and which are on earth; even in him:
- ¹¹ In whom also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestinated according to the purpose of him who worketh all things *after the counsel of his own will*:

The Major Emphasis Of "The Kingdom"

- 1st Century
 - o Transition from the Law; Clay Kingdom of Israel
 - To the Everlasting Kingdom
 - Matthew 16:13-19
 - Confusion re: identity of Christ
 - Revelatory Truth re: Identity of Christ
 - Jesus giving Peter "The Keys of the Kingdom of Heaven"
 - Pentecost: Acts 2:36-39
 - o All the House of Israel; Their Children
 - o All who are "Afar Off:" [Gentiles/Non-Jews]

- 21st Century
 - o Deemphasis of Teaching regarding "Things Pertaining To the Kingdom"
 - o Acts 1:1-3
 - Jesus 40 days of Infallible Proofs
 - Teaching "Things Pertaining To the Kingdom"
 - o Acts 1:8
 - Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria, Uttermost [Gentiles]
 - o Acts 8:5-12
 - Fulfilling the Evangelistic Directive after Stephen's martyrdom
 - Gospel carried to Samaria; preaching/teaching of Philip
 - ** 8:12 Preaching the Things Concerning the Kingdom of God
 - And the Name of Jesus
 - Baptized → Men and Women

Predestination & Foreordination – Foundational Review #2

Ephesians 1:1-5

- ¹ Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, to the saints which are at Ephesus, and to the faithful in Christ Jesus:
- ² Grace be to you, and peace, from God our Father, and from the Lord Jesus Christ.
- ³ <u>Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ</u>:
- ⁴*<u>According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love:</u>
- ⁵ Having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will*.

- c. The Gospel Plan of Salvation
- d. The Kingdom/The Church ** Acts 1:1-3; Acts 8:5; 8:12

Understanding Predestination & Foreordination is the Functional Context of God's Eternal Plan of Salvation/Scheme of Redemption

- In Paul's epistle to the church at Ephesians
 - 1:4 God has chosen us [Paul writer; Church Members at Ephesus and throughout Asia Minor; 1:1 a) Saints at Ephesus and b) faithful in Christ Jesus]
 - Special Characteristics of Ephesus & Asia Minor
 - Acts 18:18-23 Close/End of Paul's 2nd Missionary Journey
 - o Departs from Corinth; headed to Antioch in Syria
 - Accompanied by Aquila & Priscilla
 - Comes to synagogue of 1) reasons with Jews 2) refused Jews request to stay longer 3) determined to make the forthcoming Jewish Feast at Jerusalem
 - o Promises to return, Lord willing
 - o Lands at Caesarea by the sea in Palestine
 - Salutes the church at Antioch in Syria
 - Acts 18:24-28
 - o Apollos of Alexandria comes to synagogue in Ephesus
 - Mighty and eloquent; knowing and teaching only the "Baptism of John"
 - ▶ Primary 1st Century Predestination & Foreordination Context: conversion from Judaism/The Law
 - Aquila and Priscilla pull Apollos aside and expound teach "The Way of God More Perfectly/Completely
 - ** NO Baptisms Converts at Ephesus
 - Acts 19:1-10
 - Paul returns, came to Ephesus (while Apollos is in Corinth) and found certain disciples who had only been taught the "Baptism of John" [1st Century Context]
 - o Baptized them; 12: Number of Men
 - o ** 19:8 Paul teaches "in the synagogue 3 months

- Disputing and persuading "<u>The Things</u>
 Concerning the Kingdom of God"
- 19:9-10 [*Rejection & Acceptance*x`]
 - 19:9 Jewish synagogue worshipers a) hearts hardened b) disbelief/unbelief c) spoke evil of "That Way" → including "Things Pertaining To The Kingdom"
 - Those in the Kingdom of Israel/Clay Kingdom [Daniel 2]
 - 19:10 Paul separated the disciples from the Jewish synagogue and taught in the School of Tyrannus 2 years → All dwelling in Asia Minor Jews and Greeks/Gentiles
 - o "heard the word"

Ephesus

- Acts 18:18-23 Paul reasoned with the Jews in the synagogues a) no converts/baptisms b) end of 2nd Missionary Journey/return to Palestine & Antioch in Syria
- Acts 18:24-28
 - Apollos boldly teaches "Baptism of John"
 - Taught more perfectly by Aquila and Priscilla
 - Departs to Corinth
 - Disciples in Ephesus: Synagogue worshipers believing in Jesus who comes after John the Baptist
- Acts 19:1-12
 - Church at Ephesus begins with 12 converts
 - 19:10 All in Asia Minor Jews & Greeks/Gentiles "Heard the Word"

- o Acts 1:5 Predestinated to "The Adoption of Children"
 - According to the Predestinated/Foreordained "Pleasure of God's Will"
- Acts 1:9-11 The Mystery of God's Will
 - According to His Good Pleasure Purposed in Himself
 - The Church
 - Received an Inheritance
 - Being "Predestinated according to the Purpose of God who works all things according to the "Counsel of His Own Will"
 - ** Reference Acts 2:23 "<u>The Determinate Counsel and</u> Foreknowledge of God"

Predestination & Foreordination – Foundational Review #3 Summary Components of Predestination & Foreordination

- God chose Us in Him Before the foundation of the world
 - o Ephesians 1:4
 - Us → Jews and Gentiles in Him/God
 - Epistle to Ephesian Church and all that heard the word in Asia Minor [a) 1st Converts: <u>Baptism of John</u>; b) Ephesus and All Of Asia Minor: <u>Jews and Greeks</u>
 - Acts 19:10 All that heard the word in Asia Minor heard the word both Jews and Greeks
 - *****1st Ephesian converts: 12 men [19:1-5]
 - Certain disciples
 - Baptized with the Baptism of John
 - Of Repentance
 - o Believing on the "coming" Christ Jesus
- God Predestinated Us to the Adoption of Children
 - o Ephesians 1:5
 - Us → Ephesian and Asia Minor Converts
 - Jews "Adopted out of the Law"

- Galatians 4:4-5 "Those Under the Law receive the Adoption of Sons"
- Gentiles Adopted From
 - o Ephesians 2:11-13
 - Gentiles in the Flesh/Uncircumcision
 - Without Christ
 - Aliens from the Commonwealth of Israel
 - Strangers from the Covenants of Promise
 - Having No Hope/Without God in the World
 - Were Afar off/Now made near by the blood of Christ [
- *Predestinated Inheritance: By the Counsel of God's Own Will
 - o Ephesians 1:11
 - 9 <u>Having made known unto us the mystery of his will</u>, according to his good pleasure which he hath purposed in himself:
 - 10 That in the dispensation of the fulness of times he might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven, and which are on earth; even in him:
 - 11 In whom also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestinated according to the purpose of him who worketh all things after the counsel of his own will:
 - 1:9 God made known/revealed the mystery of His will unto the 1) church at Ephesus and 2) faithful in Christ Jesus in all of Asia Minor
 - The "Mystery of His Will" [3:4-6]
 - 3:5 In other ages not made known ... as it is now revealed to God's NT apostles and prophets
 - By the Holy Spirit
 - 3:6 Gentiles 1) Fellowheirs 2) members of the same body 3) partakers of the same promise [as Israel/Abraham's Promised Seed Nation]
 - 3:9 Fellowship of the Mystery From the beginning of the world/aion
 - From the beginning of the world/aion

- World/Universe/Perpetuity of Human Time/Eternity
- 1:9 According to his good pleasure which he hath purposed in himself
- 1:11 In whom also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestinated according to the purpose of him who worketh all things after the counsel of his own will:
 - **Output** We/Ephesians and Faithful in Asia Minor
 - *Obtained an Inheritance
 - *Being <u>Predestinated</u>
 - 1) According to the purpose of Him
 - 2) Who Works all things after the Counsel of His own will
 - 3) Previously Hidden from the Foundation of the World
 - Might be known/revealed by "The Church" ** Ephesians 3:8-10
- Ephesians 3:8-10 [Hidden: Predestinated & Foreordained "From The Beginning of the World"
 - 8 Unto me, who am less than the least of all saints, is this grace given, that I should <u>preach among the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of</u> Christ;
 - 9 And to <u>make all men see what is the fellowship of the mystery</u>, which from the beginning of the world hath been hid in God, who created all things by Jesus Christ:
 - 10 To the intent that now unto the principalities and powers in heavenly places ***MIGHT BE KNOWN BY THE CHURCH*** the manifold wisdom of God
 - The Role, Scope & Function of the Church → to make known/reveal the Manifold Wisdom of God.
 - Preach the unsearchable riches of Christ to the Gentiles

- Make all nations/ethnicities see the "Fellowship of the Mystery"
 - o Previously "Hidden from the Beginning Of The World"
 - In God who created All Things by Jesus Christ

Predestination & Foreordination – Foundational Review #4 Summary Components of Predestination & Foreordination

Predestinate/Predestination: Romans 8:28-30 "In Context Of???"

Romans 8:28-30

- ²⁸ And <u>WE KNOW THAT ALL THINGS WORK TOGETHER FOR GOOD TO</u>
 <u>THEM THAT LOVE GOD, TO THEM WHO ARE THE CALLED ACCORDING</u>
 TO HIS PURPOSE.
- ²⁹ For whom <u>He did foreknow</u>, <u>He also did predestinate</u> to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren.
- ³⁰ Moreover whom He did predestinate, them He also called: and whom he called, them He also justified: and whom he justified, them he also glorified.
- 1) The general statement, understanding and references
 - a. All things work together for good for them that love God, to them that are called according to His Purpose
 - b. Generally → Everything that happens/transpires in life
- 2) Who does this statement/concept mean/reference in the Context of Paul's Holy Spirit given epistle to the church at Rome
- 3) 8:28 → For "We Know"
 - a. Who is We in the epistle to the Romans/Romans 8?
- 4) 8:29 Whom God did "Foreknow" He also did "Predestinate"
 - a. Foreknow [G4267] Proginsoko (prog-in-oce'-ko)
 - i. To have knowledge beforehand (to foresee)
 - ii. To foreknow (ordain)
 - iii. To predestinate
 - b. Predestinate [G4309] Prooizo (pro-or-id'-zo) [from G4253 & G3724]
 - i. To predetermine, decide before hand
 - ii. Of God in the NT decreeing from Eternity
 - iii. To Foreordain, appoint beforehand

Context of the Epistle To Rome:

- Who is the "We" in we know 8:28
- Romans 1:1-3

- o Author Paul Called
- o Separated unto the Gospel of God
 - Which God promised before by
 - Prophets in the Holy Scriptures
 - Concerning Jesus Christ "Our" Lord
 - Made of the Seed of David according to the flesh
 - Hebrew flesh

Romans 1:4 Jesus →

- Declared to be the Son of God with Power
 - By the resurrection from the dead

Romans 1:7-13

- 1:13-17 → Fruit among you Romans as "other Gentiles"
 - o Ready to preach the gospel to you at Rome also
 - Jews and Gentiles
 - Transition from Walking in the Flesh/Law vs. Spirit/Christ Jesus [8:1-10]
 - Living & Being Led by The Spirit/Christ vs The Flesh/Law [8:11-14]
 - Receiving "Adoption & Heirship" [8:15-19]
 - Creature Waiting for and Receiving [8:20-25]
 - Foreknowledge & Predestination [8:26-30]
