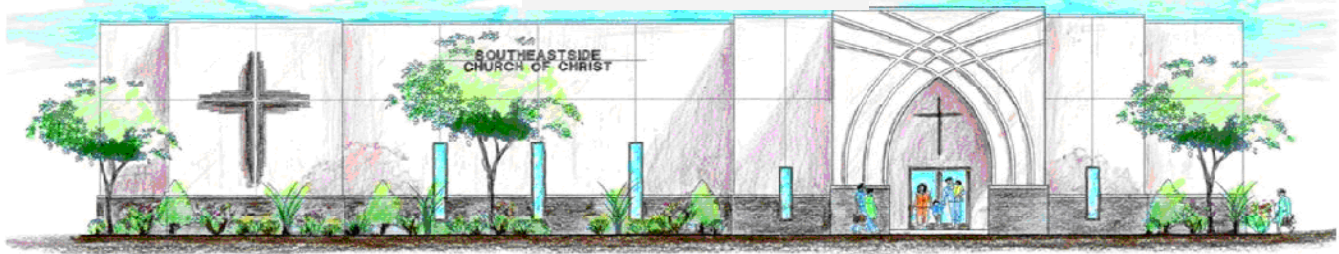

Water From A Rock

We extend greetings to the church at SouthEastSide with the bishops, the deacons, and the power that sits in the pews. **The Exodus of Israel out of Egypt found the people of God pitched in the “Wilderness of Sin” in Rephidim; they were led to a place where there was no water to drink.**

¹ And all the congregation of the children of Israel journeyed from the wilderness of Sin, after their journeys, according to the commandment of the Lord, and pitched in Rephidim: and there was no water for the people to drink. ² Wherefore the people did chide with Moses, and said, Give us water that we may drink. And Moses said unto them, Why chide ye with me? wherefore do ye tempt the Lord? ³ And the people thirsted there for water; and the people murmured against Moses, and said, Wherefore is this that thou hast brought us up out of Egypt, to kill us and our children and our cattle with thirst? ⁴ And Moses cried unto the Lord, saying, What shall I do unto this people? they be almost ready to stone me. ⁵ And the Lord said unto Moses, Go on before the people, and take with thee of the elders of Israel; and thy rod, wherewith thou smotest the river, take in thine hand, and go. ⁶ Behold, I will stand before thee there upon the rock in Horeb; and thou shalt smite the rock, and there shall come water out of it, that the people may drink. And Moses did so in the sight of the elders of Israel. ⁷ And he called the name of the place Massah, and Meribah, because of the chiding of the children of Israel, and because they tempted the Lord, saying, Is the Lord among us, or not? [Exodus 17:1-7] It is interesting to note that Israel was led by God, through His chosen earthen leadership vessel Moses, to a place in the “Wilderness of Sin” where water was unavailable to/for the people of God. There immediate unfaithful, unbelieving response was murmuring and complaining that they that been to be killed, along with there children and cattle. They did not exhibit: an appreciation of 1) God’s recent 10 miraculous plagues on Egypt 2) the recent deliverance from Pharaoh’s pursuing army that was drowned in the Red Sea. As the 7th generation from faithful father Abraham, the first generation promise of deliverance was completely ignored. ¹⁸ In the same day the Lord made a covenant with Abram, saying, Unto thy seed have I given this land, from the river of Egypt unto the great river, the river Euphrates. [Genesis 15:18] **God provided them water from A Rock [Exodus 17:5-6]**
