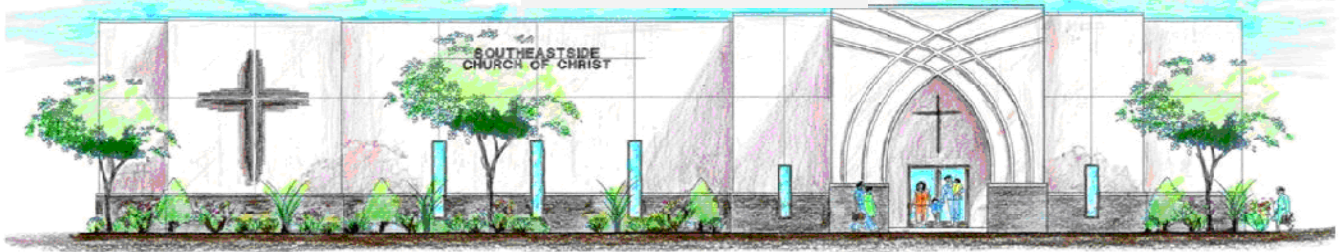

A Message From The Minister In The Palatial Facilities Of Emerald City



Learning Contentment In Multiple Circumstances

We extend greetings to the church at SouthEastSide with the bishops and the power that sits in the pews in the Palatial Facilities of Emerald City. The Apostle Paul is a pristine example of personal growth and development from where an individual is and was to where God desires us to be.

¹Therefore, my brethren dearly beloved and longed for, my joy and crown, so stand fast in the Lord, my dearly beloved ²I beseech Euodias, and beseech Syntyche, that they be of the same mind in the Lord. ³And I intreat thee also, true yokefellow, help those women which labored with me in the gospel, with Clement also, and with other my fellowlabourers, whose names are in the book of life. ⁴Rejoice in the Lord always: and again I say, Rejoice. ⁵Let your moderation be known unto all men. The Lord is at hand. ⁶Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. ⁷And the peace of God, which passeeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. ⁸Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things. ⁹Those things, which ye have both learned, and received, and heard, and seen in me, do: and the God of peace shall be with you. ¹⁰But I rejoiced in the Lord greatly, that now at the last your care of me hath flourished again; wherein ye were also careful, but ye lacked opportunity. ¹¹**Not that I speak in respect of want: for I have learned, in whatsoever state I am, therewith to be content.** ¹²I know both how to be abased, and I know how to abound: every where and in all things I am instructed both to be full and to be hungry, both to abound and to suffer need. ¹³I can do all things through Christ which strengthens me. [Philippians 4:1-13] It is crystal clear in Paul's epistle to the church at Phillipi, that he had progressed to a point in his life and walk with Christ where **he had learned to be content in whatsoever state/status he was in.** The ability to be content in the multiple circumstances of life 1) is not accomplished inherently or naturally and 2) is acquired sequentially and chronologically by the process of enlightenment, edification and maturation. We like Paul must learn to be content a multiplicity of circumstances, some of the which are 1) difficult 2) beyond our control and 3) antithetical to the will of God.

Now SouthEastSide we commend you to God and to the word of His grace, which is able to build us up in the most holy faith and to give us an inheritance among all those who are sanctified.
