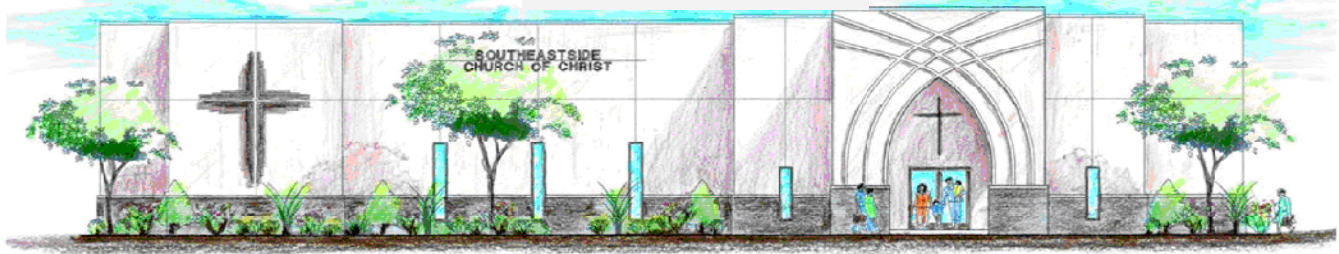

We extend greetings to the church at SouthEastSide with the bishops and the power that sits in the pews. Moses was in a prime time position watching his father in law's sheep in the land of Midian. He turned from his Cush/Cushy life to see a Bush Burning that was not consumed.

¹ And Now Moses kept the flock of Jethro his father in law, the priest of Midian: and he led the flock to the backside of the desert, and came to the mountain of God, even to Horeb. ² And the angel of the Lord appeared unto him in a flame of fire out of the midst of a bush: and he looked, and, behold, the bush burned with fire, and the bush was not consumed. ³ And Moses said, I will now turn aside, and see this great sight, why the bush is not burnt. ⁴ And when the Lord saw that he turned aside to see, God called unto him out of the midst of the bush, and said, Moses, Moses. And he said, Here am I. ⁵ And he said, Draw not nigh hither: put off thy shoes from off thy feet, for the place whereon thou standest is holy ground. ⁶ Moreover he said, I am the God of thy father, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob. And Moses hid his face; for he was afraid to look upon God. ⁷ And the Lord said, I have surely seen the affliction of my people which are in Egypt, and have heard their cry by reason of their taskmasters; for I know their sorrows; ⁸ And I am come down to deliver them out of the hand of the Egyptians, and to bring them up out of that land unto a good land and a large, unto a land flowing with milk and honey; unto the place of the Canaanites, and the Hittites, and the Amorites, and the Perizzites, and the Hivites, and the Jebusites. ⁹ Now therefore, behold, the cry of the children of Israel is come unto me: and I have also seen the oppression wherewith the Egyptians oppress them. ¹⁰ Come now therefore, and I will send thee unto Pharaoh, that thou mayest bring forth my people the children of Israel out of Egypt. **[Exodus 3:1-10]** Moses' life progressed from "Chaos & Conflict to Comfort & Convenience". When Joseph died a new king arose in Egypt that knew not Joseph who said that the people of the children of Israel are more and mightier than we are. In this Chaotic Context Moses was raised by Pharaoh's daughter, left Egypt when Pharaoh sought to kill him and ended up in Midian with a Cush/Cushy position as the priest's son in law. **Moses made a decision to turn from his Cush/Cushy life of Comfort and Convenience to answer the Call of God.**

Now SouthEastSide we commend you to God and to the word of His grace, which is able to build us up in the most holy faith and to give us an inheritance among all those who are sanctified.
