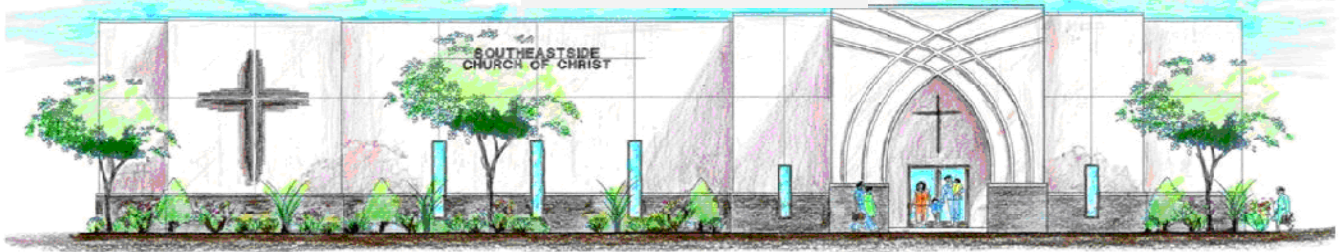

A Message From The Minister In The Palatial Facilities Of Emerald City

A Mighty Man and A Miniature Maid

We extend greetings to the church at SouthEastSide with the bishops and the power that sits in the pews in the Palatial Facilities of Emerald City. **Naaman the Syrian was a Mighty Man of Valor in the army of Syria who experienced recovery of leprosy with assistance from a small maid.**

¹ Now Naaman, captain of the host of the king of Syria, was a great man with his master, and honorable, because by him the Lord had given deliverance unto Syria: he was also a mighty man in valor, but he was a leper. ² And the Syrians had gone out by companies and had brought away captive out of the land of Israel a little maid; and she waited on Naaman's wife. ³ And she said unto her mistress, Would God my lord were with the prophet that is in Samaria! for he would recover him of his leprosy. ⁴ And one went in, and told his lord, saying, Thus and thus said the maid that is of the land of Israel. ⁵ And the **king of Syria said, Go to, go, and I will send a letter unto the king of Israel.** And he departed, and took with him ten talents of silver, and six thousand pieces of gold, and ten changes of raiment. ⁹ So Naaman came with his horses and with his chariot, and stood at the door of the house of Elisha. ¹⁰ And Elisha sent a messenger unto him, saying, Go and wash in Jordan seven times, and thy flesh shall come again to thee, and thou shalt be clean. ¹¹ But Naaman was wroth, and went away, and said, Behold, I thought, He will surely come out to me, and stand, and call on the name of the Lord his God, and strike his hand over the place, and recover the leper. ¹² Are not Abana and Pharpar, rivers of Damascus, better than all the waters of Israel? may I not wash in them, and be clean? So he turned and went away in a rage. ¹³ And his servants came near, and spake unto him, and said, My father, if the prophet had bid thee do some great thing, wouldest thou not have done it? how much rather then, when he saith to thee, Wash, and be clean? ¹⁴ Then went he down, and dipped himself seven times in Jordan, according to the saying of the man of God: and his flesh came again like unto the flesh of a little child, and he was clean. [2 Kings 5:1-5; 5:9-14] A “Miniature Maid” from the land of Israel, who was the servant of Mighty Man of Valor’s wife in Syria, had a powerful recommendation that would heal Naaman of his leprosy. Massive deliverance from God was available through a “Miniature Package”. **Healing was facilitated through the Man of God vs. the King of Israel.**
