18:17-19 Aquila and Priscilla; Paul in synagogue departed for Antioch (feast Jerusalem) ** Arrives at Ephesus Acts 18:19 **

20-21 Return again if God Will

18:24 Apollos → mighty in the scripture → Law, Prophets, Psalms

Taught more Perfectly → Went to Achaia/Greece

19:1 Paul came through the upper coast/Ephesus

History of the Mission Journeys to Ephesus:

- 1st Instance: Acts 18:19 → End of 2nd Missionary Journey
 - o 18:1-18 Paul's volatile ministry @ Corinth
 - 0 18:18
 - Paul leaves Corinth sailing to/towards Syria (Antioch)
 - Took Priscilla and Aquila with him
 - Saved his head and took a vow @ Cenchrea
 - o 18:19 Paul comes to Ephesus [on his way to Palestine/Antioch, Syria
 - Leaves Aquila and Priscilla in Ephesus
 - Paul enters synagogue at Ephesus and reasons with the Jews
 - No written/documented/Holy Spirit revealed conversions in synagogue @ Ephesus
 - o <u>18:20-21 Asked by synagogue worshipers to stay longer:</u>
 - Paul refuses and sails away from Ephesus
 - End of 2nd Missionary Journey

- o 18:22 Arrives in Palestine via sailing @ Caesarea by the Sea
 - Salutes the church at Ceasarea and travels to Antioch in Syria
 - End of 2nd Missionary Journey
- o 18:23 Begins 3rd Missionary Journey
 - Departs Antioch, Syria
 - Goes through regions of Galatia Phrygia
- o 18:24-28 Apollos came to Ephesus
 - Born @ Alexandria; mighty and eloquent in the scriptures (Law, Prophets, Psalms
 - Spoke boldly to Jews in the synagogue @ Ephesus
 - Knowing and preaching teaching only "The Baptism of John"
 - Aquila and Priscilla took him aside and taught him the gospel message more completely/perfect
 - Apollos convinced Ephesus synagogue worshipers/Jews that Jesus was Christ/Messiah/Anointed One (that was prophesied in scripture)
- o 19:1-6 Paul arrives in upper coasts of Ephesus: 3rd Missionary Journey
 - Found Baptism of John disciples who were unaware of Jesus' ministry
 - Paul 1) taught them 2) baptized them 3) then laid hands on them and they received the miraculous measure of the Holy Ghost
- o The Uproar @ Ephesus: Gentile Context Acts 19:8-41
 - **19:8-12**
 - Jewish Synagogue Rejection
 - 2 Years teaching in the school of Tyrannus
 - o All in Asia Minor (Jews and Greeks) heard the word
 - 19:13-17 **Jewish opposition**
 - Vagabond Jews/7 sons of Sceva
 - **19:18-41**
 - Effectual teaching in Ephesus
 - Demetrius the silversmith
 - The Ephesian goddess Diana
